

J. MARIE BAILEY





ABBY CASH





DAVID KARL LEE





ADONUS MABRY





PHILIP PRETE



Donald has written several successful productions which have had beginnings at the Orlando Fringe Festival (From Here; Once I Laughed; Gorgeous; Bitch, Perfect) and his production of Flying Lessons enjoyed great success in 2019 at the New York Musical Festival. Donald also founded the Theatre Program at Central Florida Community Arts, where he produced and directed over 30 productions in five full seasons of Theatre. Donald is also an educator, having taught at Valencia College for ten years, and was also an Adjunct at Stetson University and once upon a time he taught high school Theatre for seven years. Donald received his degrees from New York University (MA) and Florida State University (BA). KATHLEEN WESSEL - (CHOREOGRAPHER)



Kathleen Wessel is a movement artist, choreographer, director, writer, and educator from Orlando, Florida. She holds an MFA in Dance Performance and Choreography from Florida State University and a BA in Psychology from Emory University. Currently, Kathleen is a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Dance Performance & Choreography at Spelman College and director of Spelman Dance Theatre.

Katheen's choreographic research explores the intersections between narrative movement, devised theater, and live performance in non-traditional spaces. With Brooklyn-based artist Kelly Bartnik, Kathleen co-directs HEREafter, a long-running episodic immersive theater production based in Atlanta. Kathleen also served as associate director and co-choreographer for The Georgia Incarceration Performance Project Presents: *By Our Hands*, an award-winning devised archives-to-performance production exploring the history of convict labor in Georgia.

CHRIS KAMPMEIER (PRODUCER/ SOUND DESIGN)

Chris Kampmeier is the co-founder of Renaissance Theatre Company as well as a computer and sound engineer. Previous credits include guitar for From Here at the Orlando Fringe Festival; drums and percussion for Flying Lessons at the New York Musical Festival and the full run of From Here, then Oscar Wilde and Jesus Christ Walk Into a Gay Bar; and sound design for all the things.

ADAM PROSPER LEDO (COSTUME DESIGN)

Sarah is an Orlando native with a BFA in Studio Art from Florida State University. She began working in theater in 2016 as a volunteer scenic painter for Central Florida Community Arts where she fell in love with live theater. She now splits her time as scenic designer, scenic painter and props master at several theaters in Central Florida.

JOSHUA E. GALLAGHER (SCENIC DESIGN: V-BAR)

OSHUA E. GALLAGHER has been designing imaginary places in real spaces for the past decade and has a diverse portfolio in both scale and genre. He especially succeeds at reimagining musical spectacles for intimate venues; creating immersive storytelling experiences. His work has been featured in productions for University of Cincinnati, Villanova University, Bloomsburg Theatre Ensemble, Mac-Haydn Theatre, Limelight Performing Arts Center, Millbrook Playhouse, and Kalamazoo Civic Theatre, among others. He is an Affiliated Artist with the Bloomsburg Theatre Ensemble, and a former resident of the Philadelphia Design Center. His design for the premiere production of *In Quietness* was awarded the 2013 Kennedy Center American College Theater Festival Region II Scenic Design Award. In July 2013, Joshua participated as a Design Fellow at the National Playwrights Conference at the Eugene O'Neill Theater Center. Joshua has a Master of Fine Arts from the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music and a Bachelor of Arts in Theater from the Indiana University of Pennsylvania. Her graphic design work was seen in themed brochures and props for Bright Young Things (Creative City Project, 2020) and posters for Jeremy Seghers's production of The Woman in Black (2020), Three Stories (The Timucua House, 2018), and War Paint (Lily Garnett/Orlando Fringe, 2019). Her photography has been used by the Orlando Fringe Festival, CFCArts, and The Orlando Artist Guild.
